

Following our conversations yesterday re: the RFC Fanzone, as it stands at the moment & in view of the objections, particularly from the Community Council we are unable to sanction the use of the Ibrox Football Complex for the RFC Fanzone, under these circumstances.

However, we have been made aware that the next Ibrox & Cessnock Community Council (ICCC) meeting is this coming Wednesday. As such both myself and representatives from RFC will be attending that meeting with a view to presenting the proposals for the RFC Fanzone to them and alleviating any concerns they may have which led to the objections being submitted to GCC Licensing.

If it is acceptable to GCC Licensing, Glasgow Sport would like to make a final decision on whether we continue to approve the use of the facilities at Ibrox Football Centre for the RFC Fanzone planned for 11th August once we have attended that ICCC meeting on Wednesday evening and have an updated understanding of their position on the matter? I would be able to provide written confirmation to you on Thursday morning.
