

## IBROX/RANGERS INFORMATION

- [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] met with [REDACTED] and his team earlier in the year and offered some advice and support in the development of a fan zone for 2018/19 season.
- We passed on contacts for H&S and event management support. Rangers have engaged with these companies.
- We passed on some concept ideas for food and beverage (Big Feed concept in Govan) and again Rangers have engaged.
- [REDACTED] has visited the site on a match day pre-game to understand what happens at the minute.
- [REDACTED] met key representatives during that visit including [REDACTED] of [REDACTED].
- Rangers continue to keep [REDACTED] updated on the progress of their licence.
- Rangers plan to operate their Fanzone on a trial basis for their first 4 x home fixtures scheduled for 3pm K/offs on Saturdays only (excluding any Celtic, Aberdeen or Hibs matches which may be aligned to that day/time). Confirmed fixtures are released by the SPL 15<sup>th</sup> June.
- It is anticipated that the first Fanzone will be on Sat 11<sup>th</sup> August. Celtic as Champions will play at Parkhead on week 1 (RFC therefore away that week) so RFC have requested a Saturday 3pm fixture for week 2, 11<sup>th</sup> Aug.
- The Fanzone will include the likes of community soccer activity, stage with live music & PA, Rangers Players/Legends Q&A, F&B Vendors (incl' alcohol, license pending), LED screens showing past match highlights etc, photo opportunities & Broxi Bear mascot, promotional stands for local businesses & RFC sponsors.
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
