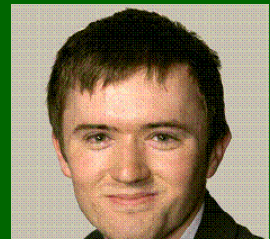

East Pollokshields Conservation Area

This year Pollokshields celebrates its 160th anniversary. In recognition of this the 'garden suburb' was nominated for the Great Neighbourhood Award by the Academy of Urbanism. They deemed the area a "Georgian and Victorian urban village".

The West Pollokshields Conservation Area Appraisal has also been published to coincide with the anniversary. An appraisal for East Pollokshields will be published very soon. Three heritage booklets will also be produced: the first two will be heritage walks and the third will be information on the architecture in Pollokshields. This follows on from the publication of a leaflet on Maxwell Park and the successful installation of notice boards in the Park.

Refuse Collection Service

The refuse and recycling collection service has changed and now operates 7 days a week. Your green bin is now emptied every two weeks (**this excludes tenements**). As part of the push to increase recycling targets and help you recycle as much of your waste as possible, the Council has replaced small blue bins with large blue bins. This will enable you to recycle more including cardboard. Items that can't be recycled at home can be taken to the recycling centres at Polmadie and Shieldhall. Opening hours are 8am to 8pm Monday to Sunday.

The bulk uplift service for tenements has reverted to a backcourt collection (**excludes tenements with service lanes**). This will result in a significant improvement in street cleanliness. Households affected will be notified of these changes by letter.

Home Insulation Scheme

The Scottish Government's Home Insulation Scheme was introduced in 2009. Following the introduction of the scheme, councils were invited to submit proposals for suitable properties for the scheme and based on the need to deal with the least energy efficient housing stock Glasgow City Council's bid for 2011/12 has focused on areas dominated by pre 1919 properties.

Therefore Pollokshields East, Pollokshields West and Strathbungo neighbourhoods are included. It is primarily aimed at providing basic insulation measures and energy advice to householders. In doing this the council will be working in partnership with Southside Housing Association.

Roads Investments in Pollokshields

Glasgow City Council plans to spend money on resurfacing schemes, permanent carriageway patching, manhole repairs and temporary patching work. Completed or planned resurfacing schemes and patching works in Pollokshields Ward since 2007:

- Matilda Road – from Albert Drive to Maxwell Drive
- Sherbrooke Avenue – from Nithsdale Road to Hamilton Avenue
- Sherbrooke Avenue – from Albert Drive to St Andrews Drive
- Albert Drive – from Nithsdale Road to Terregles Avenue
- Dalziel Drive – from Sherbrooke Avenue to Albert Drive
- Nithsdale Road – various sections
- Fotheringay Road – from Darnley Road to Beaton Road
