DOG FOULING

Dog fouling is a major issue throughout the ward, and indeed the city as a whole. If you see any incidents, please don't ignore them – dog fouling spreads disease, and the minority of dog owners who don't take responsibility for their pets spoil the community for everyone else. Report them to the Council on 0800 027 7027. There are a number of steps that can be taken to force irresponsible dog owners to clean up their act, but the council needs to know who is responsible before they can act to stop it.

FLY TIPPING

I have been dealing with quite a number of issues relating to fly tipping in East Centre.

There are various areas in the ward both private and public areas where fly tipping is regularly carried out. In order to deal with this problem the Council has agreed to clear the rubbish from these sites, but if it is a privately owned piece of land and the landowner does not take any action to clear the site the Council will clear the land and bill the owner.

There is a lot the Council can do to deal with fly tipping. If you know of any fly-tipping blackspots or see anyone flytipping, please let the council know.
