Please find below the latest news on the rollout of Personalisation across Glasgow:

## Learning Disabilities rollout

- Over 1,000 people with learning disabilities are involved in Personalisation.
- Around 800 have completed an outcome based support plan.
- The annual review of support plans will take place from March to December 2012.

## Physical Disabilities rollout

- 240 Self Evaluation Questionnaires (SEQ) are underway.
- 140 estimated budgets have been allocated.
- Around 800 support plans will be completed by March 2012.

## Mental Health rollout

- Phase one of the Mental Health rollout starts in March 2012.
- Approximately 810 people with mental health issues will be involved in stage one.
- Training for mental health staff within social work starts this month and will continue through to March 2012.
- Planning continues in the areas of finance, commissioning, governance, operational practice, communications, guidance and performance measurement.
- Details of preparations for rollout have been communicated to Social Work Services staff and service providers via email.

- The physical disabilities rollout will be ongoing
