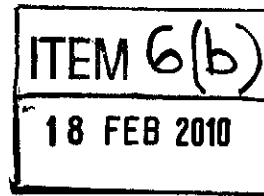

#### West Dunbartonshire Council – Improvements to A82

I refer to the meeting of West Dunbartonshire Council on 16 December 2009 at which the undernoted motion was approved:-

**The A82 is without doubt an absolute lifeline for the communities of West Dunbartonshire. There are a number of parts of the A82 which require upgrading and while this Council will continue to strive for improvements to the relevant problems that affect West Dunbartonshire commuters, we should forge a partnership of likeminded organisations with the same common goal. By joining forces with other partners and agencies, such as other local authorities, public bodies and community groups we can join in a coordinated campaign to demand that the A82 be improved and upgraded.**


**Recent work on the A82 has highlighted more than ever the need for major improvements to this essential road network as the disruptions caused to commuters has been considerable.**

**Therefore this Council agrees to instruct the Chief Executive to write to his counterparts in all relevant local authorities and the Chief Executive Officer of the National Park authority seeking their views on a joint campaign. The Council asks that officers from the relevant authorities work on drawing together a plan of each respective authority's areas of concern on the A82.**

**Once the plan has been completed all relevant partners should unite and make a joint representation to the Scottish Government.**

I shall be grateful if your Council will consider the above motion and advise me of the outcome in due course.
