

## **PUBLIC PROCESSIONS COMMITTEE'S MINUTES.**

Glasgow, 24th April 2019.

### **Public Processions Committee.**

Present: Annette Christie (Chair), Christina Cannon and Jon Molyneux.

Attending: A M Carr (Clerk); and K McDonald (for the Director of Governance and Solicitor to the Council).

#### **Appointment of Chair.**

1 The committee agreed to appoint Bailie Christie to chair the meeting.

#### **Consideration of representations in relation to public procession by All Under One Banner.**

2 There was submitted a report by the Director of Governance and Solicitor to the Council advising of considerations in relation to a proposed procession to be held by All Under One Banner on Saturday, 4th May 2019 and the failure to reach agreement on satisfactory arrangements to allow the procession to proceed resulting in the need for this committee to consider representations, in terms of the Police, Public Order and Criminal Justice (Scotland) Act 2006 and the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982, as amended, in relation to the proposed time and route of the procession.

After having heard

- (1) M Miller, Head of Licensing and Democratic Services, in further explanation of the report and who made representations regarding the risks to public safety, and disruption to the life of the local community in relation to the proposed route and time of the procession submitted by the organisation;
- (2) Superintendent S Hazlett, Police Scotland, Group Manager B Winter, Scottish Fire and Rescue Service and D Hamilton, for the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods and Sustainability; and
- (3) Mr M Singh, on behalf of All Under One Banner, in support of the proposed route,

the committee agreed

- (a) that the procession proceed on Saturday, 4<sup>th</sup> May 2019; and
- (b) to impose the following conditions:-

- (i) that the Procession will assemble in Kelvingrove Park at 1000 hours and start at 1100 hours; and
- (ii) the outward route to be taken shall be Kelvingrove Park, Kelvin Way, Sauchiehall Street, Pitt Street, West George Street, Blythswood Square, West George Street, Nelson Mandela Place, West George Street, George Square, George Street, High Street, Saltmarket, Glasgow Green.
