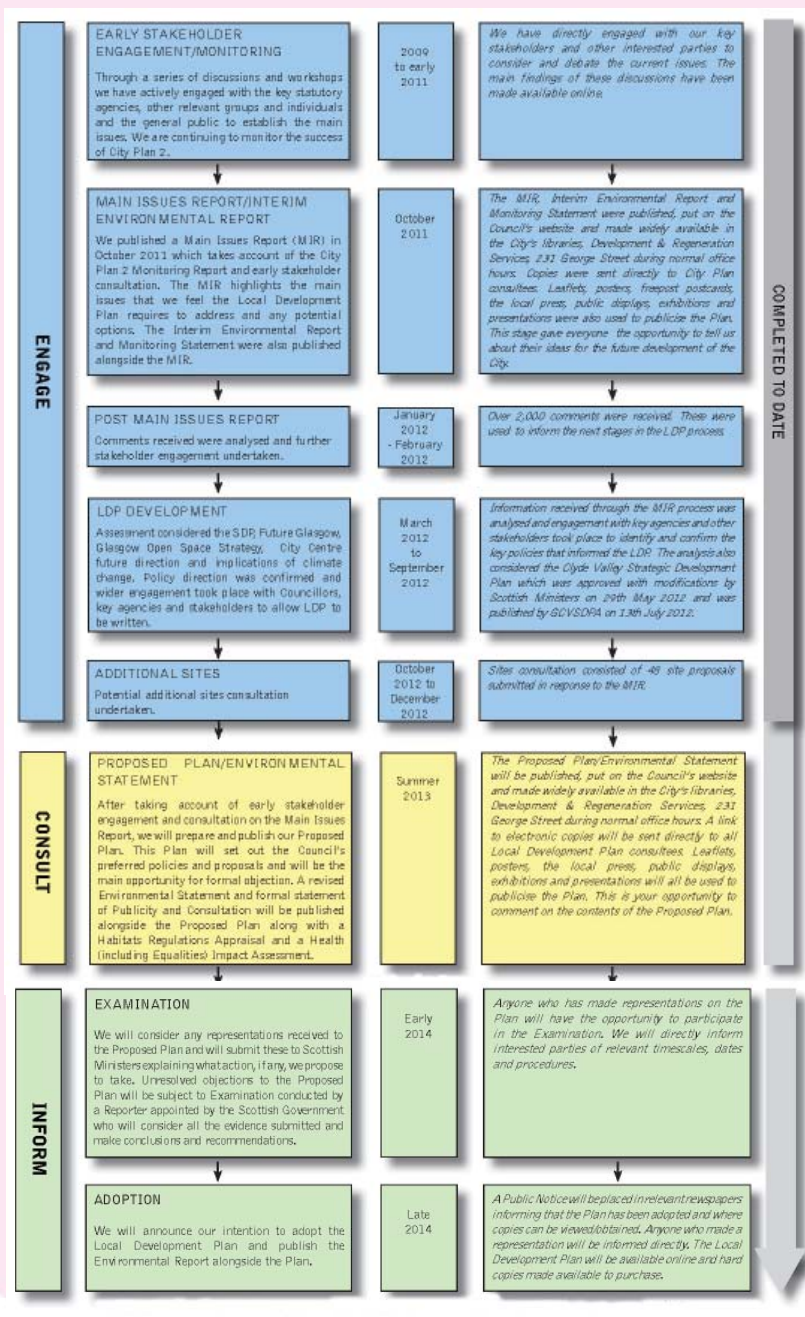




Glasgow Local Development Plan - Proposed Plan

The broad timetable for the production of the proposed Local Development Plan and the main opportunities for public participation are:



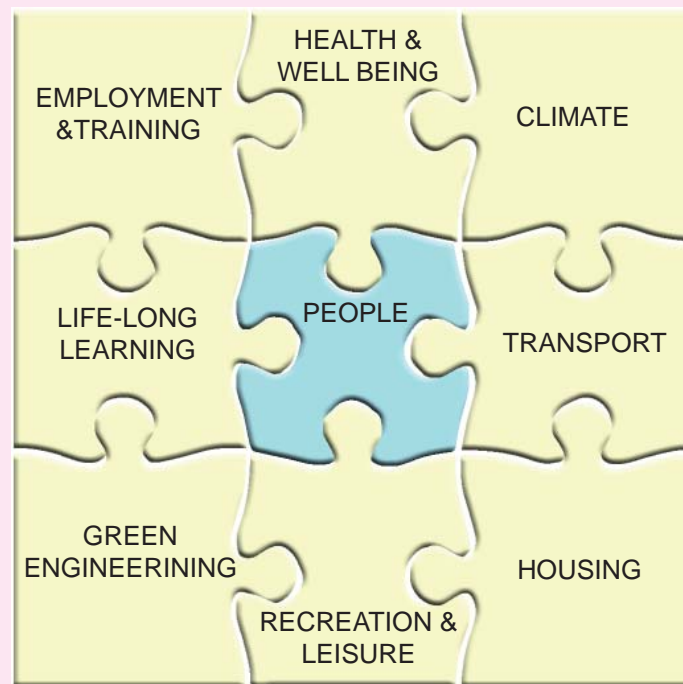

The Plan will place strong emphasis on **delivering high quality places, health and wellbeing, and sustainability.**



These principles are critical to: building on Glasgow's strengths as a place; to the City's ability to adapt to climate change; and to maximising the potential of its citizens. The Plan's clear focus should help to ensure that the City is well-positioned to meet the challenges of a changing climate and economy, and to build a resilient physical and social environment which helps attract and retain investment.

Public Consultation at Proposed Plan Stage

The Planning etc. (Scotland) Act 2006 sets out a list of statutory consultees we are required to engage, consult and inform throughout the development plan process. This includes the Scottish Government, neighbouring local authorities and key agencies such as Scottish Natural Heritage (SNH) and the Scottish Environment Protection Agency (SEPA).

In addition to this, however, we will also consult and inform a broader range of groups and individuals including:

- elected members/other Council services
- the general public
- other public sector agencies, institutions and the voluntary sector
- local communities via community councils, local housing associations and partnership organisations
- businesses and developers
- minority ethnic groups
- health professionals

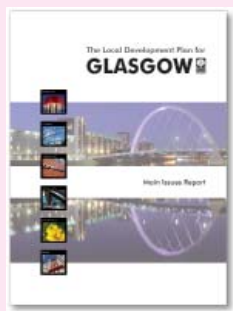
