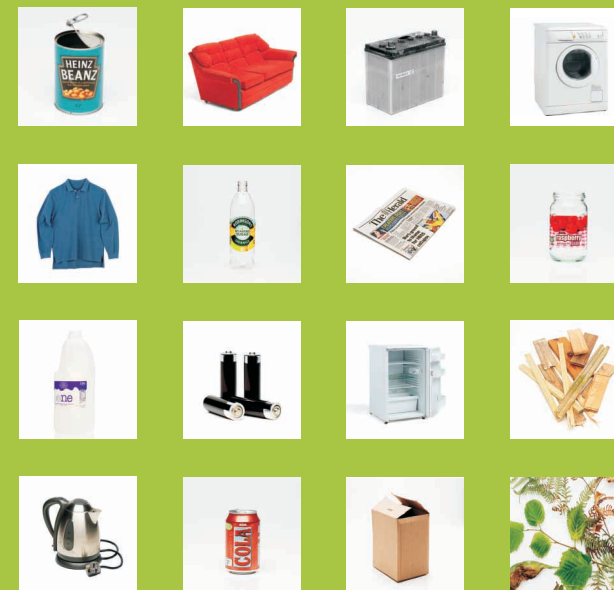
Opening Hours - Monday to Sunday 8am to 8pm (last entry 7.45pm)

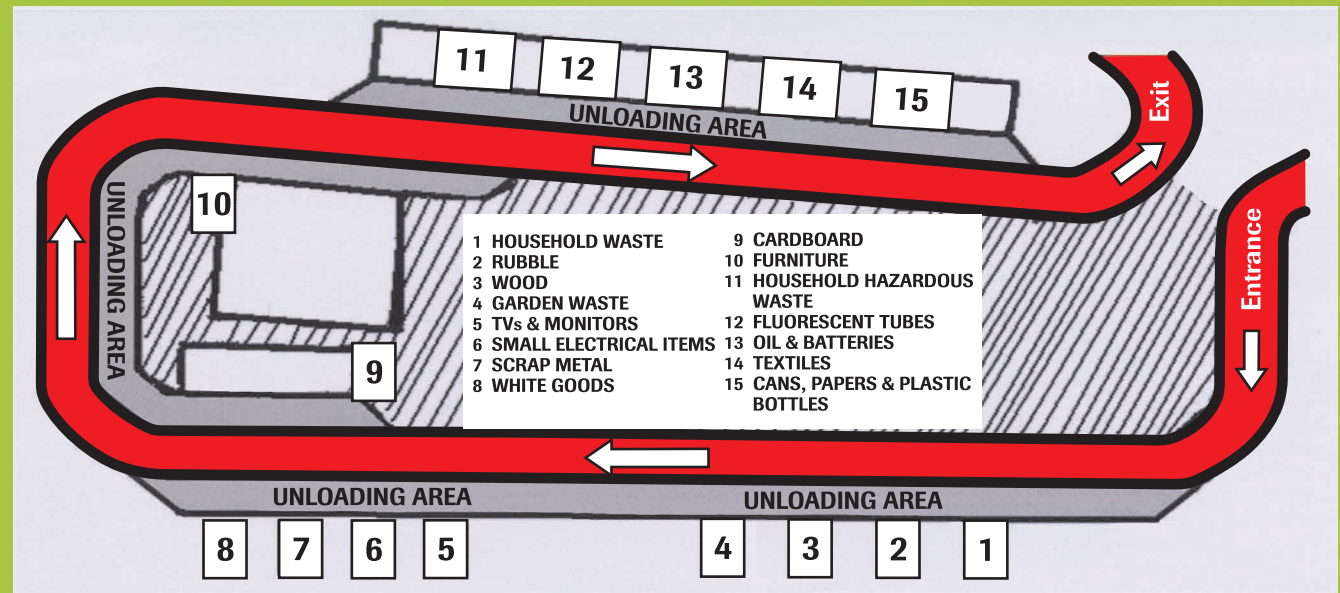
Shieldhall Recycling Centre, 200 Bogmoor Rd, G51 4SN

Household waste can also be deposited at the centre however please ensure this is non-recyclable as this material will be buried at Glasgow's landfill site.



To help reduce your time spent at the centre please segregate your recyclables before visiting the centre.

Please ensure that you deposit your recyclables loose at the correct storage bay or container as this will prevent any contamination.

Please tell the attendants what you are recycling or disposing of and they will direct you to the correct bays or containers.

The recyclables you deposit will be reprocessed by our recycling partners.

Please follow these safe working procedures when visiting the centre -

- Ensure you drive slowly
- Follow the One Way System
- No Smoking Permitted
- No U Turns
- Keep children & pets inside vehicles
