

Choosing a Venue

Glasgow Registrars have a large and experienced team who can arrange to conduct your ceremony at any agreed venue throughout the city. We also have Ceremony Rooms at 23 Montrose Street and the City Chambers.

Ceremony

Your ceremony is personal to you both, whether you want intimate, elaborate, traditional or contemporary, we can help create that special day. To make the ceremony more personal, couples may wish to incorporate readings, poetry and your own vows or include a symbolic gesture like handfasting, rose or candle ceremony. You may also have your own ideas that the Registrar would be happy to discuss with you.

Legal Preliminaries to Marriage

To be married in Scotland each party to a marriage should complete an **M10 form** and provide relevant documents to the Registrar in the district where the ceremony is taking place. The forms and guidance notes can be downloaded and information on the

required documents can be found at www.nrscotland.gov.uk Marriage notice forms, relevant documents and fee should be submitted 8 to 10 weeks before the ceremony. This can be done by making an appointment to come along to our office at 45 John Street, Glasgow.

Ceremony Bookings

We take bookings for ceremonies up to two years in advance.
