

Beauty at Glasgow Kelvin College, Springburn and Easterhouse campuses

EVIP Beauty is designed to help you develop the skills and knowledge required to work within the Beauty environment with the view to moving into employment, education or training when leaving School. You will also develop your employability skills and explore the world of work through the opportunity of work experience.

As part of the course, you will continue to work towards qualifications in English and Lifeskills Mathematics and will still receive PSE (guidance) and PE classes.

Dance Leader Award You will lead small groups in simple dance activities, whilst under the direct supervision of a Tutor/Assessor or other suitably qualified adult. What happens next?

You will be referred to EVIP via your current School. You will then have the opportunity to attend an Information Sharing session and then you will be invited to attend a Taster Session at Glasgow Kelvin College, Easterhouse Campus.

Courses start in August and you will transfer from their current school roll to the roll of EVIP. You will attend EVIP 5-days each week and classes run from 9.30am-3.15pm. You will be given an appropriate travel card to allow you to travel independently to and from EVIP/College.

Learning will be delivered in a variety of environments including a professional salons, classroom, IT suite and Sports Centre.

All pupils in the class will be supported by an EVIP Officer/Vocational Coach. They will provide pastoral care, guidance and support at all times during the school day. Pupils are not permitted to leave the College Campus after they have arrived in the morning.

What opportunities are there after EVIP?

You can train as a beauty therapist either full-time or part-time at a college. You could also work as a trainee, where you would learn on the job and go to college on day release. To become a beauty therapist, you will need to have customer service and 'people' skills. You'll need creativity and an awareness of fashion. You'll also need a willingness to learn new techniques and methods.

You could work as a beauty therapist in salons UK and Worldwide. You could also find opportunities in a number of other places, such as shops, spas, hotels, care homes and cruise ships. Another option could be to work freelance, travelling to clients' homes rather than working in a salon.

With experience you could progress to jobs like lecturer or salon manager. By taking suitable further qualifications, you could move into training or assessing. Other options include make-up artistry, semi-permanent make-up techniques and working in the theatre, film and television industries.

There is a wide variety of roles for people who have a good work ethic and a desire to provide excellent customer service. Young people have access to weekly sessions on Employability and will have regular access to the School Careers Advisor from Skills Development Scotland to ensure that they receive the appropriate level of advice and information.
