

Santa Dash – Frequently Asked Questions

Registering

Q. Can you register to run on the day?

A. No. Unfortunately there will be no registrations on the day.

Q. Are there any discounts for group bookings?

A. No?

Q. What age is an 'adult' and what age is a 'child'?

A. A child is anyone under the age of 16 unless they are in full time education we will then allow them to pay a child entry fee up to 18.

Q. Do I need to register a baby?

A. Babies do not have to be registered however they will not receive a suit or medal.

Q. What do you mean by a small adult suit?

A. A small adult suit will fit the equivalent of a ladies' size 8-10 otherwise the normal adult size will be required. Please note the small suit does not come with a beard.

Q. Can I register more than one person at a time?

A. Yes. The person who is registering the group should enter their own details on the form and order the number of suits they need for the group. An email will go to the person who has registered the group to tell them when they can collect their suits. Remember the email will go to the email address you register with.

Q. I already have a Santa Suit. Do I still have to pay the full £15.00?

A. Yes.

Q. What do I get for my registration fee?

A. You get your Santa Suit (this includes trousers, a jacket, hat and belt. Only the larger adult suit has a beard), race number and medal.

Q. Who do I contact if I have a problem with registering for the Santa Dash?

Once you have registered

Q. When will I receive my race pack?

A. Race information will be sent out by email as soon as you register to the email address provided when registering.

Q. Where do I collect my Santa Suit from?

A. Santa Suits can be collected from the St Enoch Centre.

Remember to 'Carry a Carrier' when you collect your Santa suit. If you request a bag, you will be charged 5p for it.

Q. How will I receive my race number?

A. Race numbers will be allocated when you collect your suit. It is important for Health and Safety reasons that the contact details at the back of these numbers are completed before the start of the race.

Q. Can you post out the Santa suits?

A. No – This would raise the cost of the event with less money going to charity.

On the Day

Q. What date is the Santa Dash?

A. The Santa Dash is on Sunday 09 December 2018.

Q. What time does the event start?

A. Muster is at 9.30am where you will be allocated your race group. The race will move off at 10am.

Q. Where does the event begin?

A. George Square

Q. I want to run with my six month old baby, can I do that?

A. Yes – however everyone with buggies should run in last group.

Q. Can I bring my dog along to the race?

A. Yes – however you should run in last group.

Q. Can I wear my own Santa Suit/dress?

A. Yes. However you must still pay the registration fee and collect a race number.

Q. Can I run for my own charity or does it have to be for the nominated ones?

A. We try to encourage everyone to run for the nominated charities however you can also run for your own charity.

Q. Can I leave my bag anywhere?

A. No – There are no facilities to leave coats/bags/phones etc.
