GO LIVE! AT THE GREEN Thursday 2 - Sunday 12 AUGUST 2018

IMPORTANT INFORMATION - PLEASE READ GLASGOW 2018 EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIPS

A new era in world sport will get underway this summer as Glasgow and Berlin host the inaugural European Championships from 2-12 August 2018.

Glasgow and Scotland will host six sports (Aquatics, Cycling, Golf, Gymnastics, Rowing and Triathlon) across 12 venues in partnership with the city of Berlin which will host the Athletics.

As part of the Championships, Glasgow Green will be hosting GO LIVE! at the Green from 2-12 August, an innovative live experience bringing together sport, culture and entertainment to provide a daily programme of activities for everyone to enjoy.

Glasgow Green will also be a key sport venue during the Championships as it hosts three days of elite cycling events which are also free to attend.

Access is free, no tickets are required and the venue will be open daily from 10.00 until 19.00, except on the dates of the cycling events on 8 and 12 August when the venue opens 08.00 to 19.00.

You have received this letter because your area will be affected by GO LIVE! at the Green.

Delivering an event of this size will change how the city operates on certain days and inevitably impact the area. The requirements of the set-up and operation of these events will lead to the generation of some background noise, including a cultural and sporting programme, an increase in footfall in the area, and the use of technical equipment. Glasgow 2018 will work closely with partners to ensure the impacts of these are minimised.

Please note as a result of the cycling events on 5, 8 and 12 August, it will also be necessary to put road closures and parking restrictions in place for some of the days of operation. For further details of these please visit www.getreadyglasgow.com.

ACCESS RESTRICTIONS

Access to Glasgow Green will be restricted to the public during the set-up period, which will run from Monday 16 July to Wednesday 1 August. Safe walkways will be made available in certain areas during this period to allow public access to Glasgow Green.

From 19.30 on Sunday 12 August until 18.00 on Wednesday 15 August Glasgow Green will then be in take-down phase. It is likely there will be extended working hours during this period to ensure the removal of all GO LIVE! at the Green equipment.









The Children's Playpark will be accessible from Greendyke Street during the set-up and take-down periods. During the event, the Children's Playpark will be accessible via the spectator entry points. The two main spectator entry points are McLennan Arch (Saltmarket) and the east entrance adjacent to the Winter Gardens.

EMERGENCY SERVICES

Access for Emergency Services will be maintained at all times and they should be contacted in the normal way.

COUNCIL SERVICES

Due to the nature of the event and significant traffic management requirements there will be disruptions to a number of council services, particularly cleansing, waste and recycling operations. You will receive information through the usual channels regarding any changes to your council services on event days.

With your support, we plan to stage a spectacular GO LIVE! at the Green event that showcases the city and country and contributes to an amazing European Championships.
