Glasgow 2018 European Championships Loch Lomond Shore

(temporary traffic management) order 2018

Glasgow City Council on behalf of and including West Dunbartonshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers being satisfied that traffic on the lengths of road specified in the Schedules hereto should be prohibited or restricted to facilitate the holding of the Glasgow 2018 European Championships and to enable members of the public to watch this event and being satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for the event to be held otherwise than on a road and having had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order and with the consent of Scottish Ministers under sections 16B(1)(a),16B(6)(b) of the said act, hereby make the following Order.

PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

04:00 hours to 19:00 hours, from Sunday 5 August till Sunday 12 August 2018

- 1. Pier Road, between Ben Lomond Way and Balloch Road
- 2. Ben Lomond Way, between Aquatics Centre Service Entrance and Pier Road.

NO WAITING AND NO LOADING

16:00 hours on Saturday 4 August to 19:00 hours on Sunday 12 August 2018

- 1. Pier Road (both sides), between Ben Lomond Way and Balloch Road
- 2. Ben Lomond Way (both sides), for its entire length.

EFFECT

The Order will apply to the specified roads at the above times and dates, as indicated by appropriate traffic signs or under the instruction of a police officer in uniform and the effect will be to impose temporary restrictions on use.

DURATION

The order will come into operation on 16:00 hours on Saturday 4 of August, Two Thousand and Eighteen and shall have effect until 19:00 hours on Sunday 12 of August, Two Thousand and Eighteen.
