**1** | The Time Trial event is likely to cause significant road disruption across Glasgow, East Dunbartonshire, and Stirlingshire due to widespread road closures. Impacts will likely be most severe around the morning and evening peak hours (07:00 - 09:00 and 16:00 - 18:00). Diversions will be in place between 00:01 - 22:00 to direct traffic away from these locations. Please visit [getreadyglasgow.com](http://getreadyglasgow.com) for more details.

**2** | Key routes in the west of Glasgow could experience congestion, including the Clydeside Expressway.

**3** | On Wednesday 8 August, closures around Junction 15 westbound will cause delays and congestion on the roads. Please avoid the area and work from home if you can. Public transport or active travel will be your best options.

**4** | Road closures will be in place for the Time Trial event and significant disruption is expected in the areas around George Square, Cathedral Street, and High Street.

**5** | Due to road closures, bus services may be re-routed and some bus stops suspended.
