3. Glasgow City Council update

- a. Consultation update: [GCC online Consultation Hub](#) highlighted and current opportunities to inform GCC policy highlighted:
 - Open Space
 - Food Inequality
 - Education Services – Capital Investment

Questions arose of how GCC let the public know the outcome of consultations other than just informing Committee papers. Scottish Government model of all response being available highlighted: feedback seen as being an important part of dialogue. Social media opportunities 'You told us' approach also highlighted. Cllr Richardson to share with colleagues: noted recent review of this by the WECCE committee

b. Officer update

Updates provided on a range of developments:

- South City Way
- Community Links Plus: Woodside
- East City Way
- St Andrew's Drive
- North City Way
- Mass Transit (Energy Saving Trust)

Discussions re: on street parking; traffic enforcement; signage; 'floating' bus stops; unidirectional travel; consistency and feasibility of design and approaches across City Ways.

Agreement that these and other issues arising would inform the ongoing developments and local challenges being balanced with the view to ideally creating an integrated network

4. **Thematic input:** *Active Travel & inclusive infrastructure (including Avenues and City Deal)*

- a. Presentation provided on the above
- b. Input overwhelmingly welcomed: - noted that it is very difficult to find out what is going on across Glasgow – and to can be difficult to find out/ get an overview. On a positive note – all agreed this is because so much is going on.
- c. Cllr Richardson welcomed the positivity and asked members: whilst so much more is to be done – how can the Forum raise awareness and ensure these good news stories are communicated wider, ideally prompting modal change? (To be discussed at review day)
- d. Bike For Good noted that they offered at a previous Forum to host information on the new website "Aye,Cycle"; the website has been delayed but the aim is to have this developed by March 2019. Forum members will be consulted prior to then.

5. Wider Partner Update

- a. GCPH shared that the Schools Health & Wellbeing Survey which targets all secondary school children is due. This will include questions re how do pupils get to school, how they would like to get to school. Noted that the 2007 report 10% said they would like to go to school by bicycle. Survey response should be available in June 2019
- b. Healthy Streets Conference due to take place in Glasgow in 2019
- c. Go bike AGM Saturday 17th November 2018
