What You Can Expect From Us:

- All activities will fit into the CfE, based on the information you provide in the booking form
- The location of the activity will be checked for safety prior to your visit and a risk assessment carried out for the activity.
- All activities will have all equipment provided
- GCC staff leading the session are qualified First Aiders with a mobile phone
- Officers running the session are fully vetted by the Police
- The sessions will involve minimum disturbance to the flora and fauna of the site
- If the session has to be cancelled (due to inclement weather or staffing) it will be rearranged for a later date

What We Expect From the School:

- Teachers should take responsibility for discipline
- Teachers will be expected to supervise children when group work is needed
- No snacks permitted during the activity unless the child has dietary requirements
- To brief the children before the visit on what they will be doing
- To produce adequate supervision on the day with the use of helpers and classroom assistants. Countryside Rangers should not be counted as supervisors/supplementing the adult: child ratios
- Sites have limited and in some cases, NO toilet facilities. Children should be toileted before arriving.
- All adults & children should wear appropriate clothing and footwear for being outdoors in the countryside in inclement weather.
