UEFA EURO 2020, Glasgow, 12 June – 12 July 2020
City Centre Fan Zones
Drop-In Sessions

As part of the 60th Anniversary of the Championships, Glasgow was successful in its bid to be one of the 12 cities selected to host a unique edition of the Tournament. The Tournament commences on 12 June 2020 and will run until 12 July 2020. Glasgow will play host to four matches which will take place at Hampden Park on Monday 15, Friday 19, Tuesday 23 and Tuesday 30 June 2020.

In addition to staging the football matches, Glasgow will deliver a city centre programme of activity for the duration of the Tournament. The hub of this will be two Fan Zones which will be created in George Square and Merchant City where citizens, spectators and visitors can experience the Tournament regardless of having a match ticket for Hampden Park. George Square and Merchant City will feature cultural and sporting activity including entertainment, sponsor activations, and food and drink outlets creating a live event experience similar to the Commonwealth Games 2014 and European Championships 2018.

Hosting this event, as with any major event, will mean some changes to how the city operates. We would like to take this opportunity to talk to you about some proposed changes relating to the Fan Zones during the Tournament.

The Fan Zone in George Square will be open 12 June - 12 July 2020. The dates of operation for the Merchant City Fan Zone are currently being confirmed, however, they will fall within the period 12 June – 12 July 2020. With 200,000 people expected to visit Glasgow during UEFA EURO 2020, there can be little doubt that Glasgow is set to reap the benefits of hosting such a major event next summer. We are working hard to ensure as many people as possible can enjoy the celebrations whether at Hampden Park or in the Fan Zones and that any disruption is kept to a minimum.

We look forward to welcoming European fans and celebrating the best of European football at Hampden Park as part of one of the biggest sporting events in the world, and with a potential global television audience of up to 3.5 billion, Glasgow will again be in the spotlight during this major event.

Why have I received this letter?

As you will appreciate, delivering an event of this size within a city centre environment will likely result in disruptions and changes to servicing for residents and businesses during the Tournament. Whilst we hope to minimise the impacts, road closures and parking restrictions will be required to deliver safe and secure events.

Parking Restrictions and Road Closures

The following parking restrictions and road closures reflect the current planning assumptions for the safe delivery of the event. These may be subject to minimal changes during the final detailed operational planning period.

Public Transport

As a result of the road closures, buses and taxi services will be diverted away from George Square and the Merchant City area. Bus operators will communicate service changes in advance of the closures. Alternative taxis ranks for George Square will be on St Vincent Place and North Hanover Street. Alternative taxi ranks for Merchant City will be on Stockwell Street and London Road.

Emergency Services

Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times and they should be contacted in the normal way.

Council Services

Due to the nature of the events and traffic management requirements there will be disruptions to a number of council services, particularly cleansing, waste and recycling operations. You will receive information through the usual channels regarding any changes to your council services on event days.
