To whom it may concern.

It has been brought to my attention that plans have been drawn to transfer areas of the local Cathkin Park to the Jimmy Johnstone Academy. As a resident within 20 yards of the JJA pavilion, I strongly object to such transfer. When in use, the area around the pavilion is littered with cars parked on the pathways leading to the JJA. This is nothing but a nuisance to the residents who reside next the pavilion. I don't see what this request will bring to the area. There are more than enough sport and recreation sites near the pavilion. We have a gym in Holyrood, a football recreation stadium at Toryglen. We have lesser Hampden and the National Stadium. Adding to this, the area is a natural habitat for wildlife that will be threatened with the noise pollution from football matches and schools.... This is a serious matter and should be reconsidered... Private homeowners will raise concerns at the threat of their properties devaluating and rightly so due to this absurd transfer request.
