My name is [REDACTED] and I am a homeowner at [REDACTED]. Prior to this I resided as a tenant at [REDACTED] for [REDACTED] years. During that time I have witnessed some appalling parking and anti-social behaviour in the streets surrounding Celtic Park on match days, namely the area I live in. This has included, but is not limited to; my car being blocked in my parking space, cars parked in my private parking space, my driveway being blocked by cars, cars parking in such a manner that it is impossible to turn into or out of my driveway, irresponsible and illegal blocking and narrowing of road ways which on at least one occasion caused an ambulance crew to require to transport an elderly female on a trolley several hundred yards down her street to be transferred to hospital, urinating in the streets of fans passing by people's gardens, excessive amounts of litter thrown and dumped in and along the streets including glass beer bottles which are dropped and shatter causing danger to public and animals. All of the above noted I can provide photographic evidence of.

I am fully aware of the revenue Celtic park generates for Glasgow City and the East End of Glasgow. However if the police and GCC remain unprepared to act as required in dealing with this anti-social behaviour and removal of illegally parked vehicles, then the only choice is to support parking restrictions in the area on event days.

Therefor I would ask you to accept this as a note of my support in the proposed parking restrictions placed in the area.

With regards to the provision of a Nextbike station at the venue, Glasgow City Council has a planned roll out of hire locations over the next 6 years, due to the close proximity of the location at Emirates Arena, Celtic Park does not meet the guidelines for a publically funded station and as such will not be part of the City Council's expansion. It is also worth noting that as the land is private the City Council does not have the permissions to install a hire facility at this location. Alternatively the operational contract for Nextbike allows the operator to engage directly with private groups / firms to purchase a hire station and have it located on their property, this has already been done in several locations within Glasgow and is an option open to Celtic FC.

Regarding the segregated cycle way at Bridgeton Station to Celtic Park, this does not form part of this consultation.

Thank you for your correspondence regarding the above named Traffic Regulation Order.

I can advise that the area covered by these proposals has been highlighted as being negatively affected by current parking practices and this is why these proposals have been drawn up. It is hoped that these proposals will encourage the use of sustainable transport; however the impact these proposals would have on other areas of Glasgow cannot be determined but shall be monitored if the scheme is implemented.

A resident can purchase as many visitor permits as they require at a cost of £10 per permit, however this will be closely monitored to ensure there is no abuse of the system.

1. Dropping off and picking up can be accommodated within these proposals, anyone wishing to drop off or pick up can do so in areas where loading and unloading is permitted, e.g. within the Event Day Parking Zone. Also, supporters who feel that they require parking nearer the stadium should approach Celtic Football Club for assistance, to park in one of the car parks at the stadium.
2. The Council are not proposing any alternative parking areas. The Council wish to discourage vehicles into the area when games are on to reduce congestion. Providing car parking would be contrary to this and would be detrimental to the aim of dissuading travel by private car to stadia and event spaces in Glasgow.

Please note that valid disabled badge holders are accommodated within these proposals, disabled badge holders will be able to park within the Event Day Parking Zone as long as the disabled badge is displayed on the vehicle.

3. I can advise that my officers have met with SPT, Scotrail and bus operators to establish the current levels of service and discuss possible improvements to public transport. Bus operators have noted that no real improvement can be made due to the volume of traffic in the area both prior to and after a game. They would be happy to review this but only when there is less traffic in the area.

In addition to the above, supporter's buses would be accommodated within the zone.

4. Please note that all works or improvements to the rail infrastructure would have to be discussed with SPT and Network Rail directly.
5. Any proposed bus service that Celtic FC would be providing as an alternative mode of transport for Celtic FC supporters would have to be discussed with Celtic FC directly. However, the Council would be supportive if Celtic FC wish to provide this.
6. I can advise that as part of Glasgow City Councils Local Transport Strategy the council's aim is to reduce harmful emissions and commuter parking around the city. The restrictions on Bell Street, Hunter Street and the streets surrounding this area were put in place to tackle these issues.

### **Celtic Park and Emirates Arena – Proposed Event Day Parking Scheme**

I wanted to write and express my broad support for the parking proposals but also to raise some related matters.

Therefore, in the first place, I do want to express my strong support for these proposals. I have had numerous complaints from residents whose life has been made a misery on match days by inconsiderate parking at and near their homes. In some cases, residents are effectively trapped in their homes because their driveways have been blocked. In other cases, it is clear that a fire engine or other emergency vehicle could not enter certain streets and again this is a cause of concern and stress for local residents. Therefore, I absolutely agree that action such as this needs to be taken.

On the question of the actual boundaries of the zone, I am broadly supportive of these. I have reviewed them and they appear reasonable including the main areas where I have had complaints. Obviously there is the possibility that parking just beyond the zone boundaries will become worse and, therefore, I would urge the council to keep the boundaries of the zone under review once it has been in operation for a year or so.

The question of residents' visitor parking permits has been raised with me and how strictly these will be controlled. It might well be a temptation to some residents to take up their full allocation of permits and then sell them to visiting football fans. I am not sure how easy that would be to supervise or control.

I have also had representations from some football fans, especially Celtic supporters who need to bring their car or feel they need to bring their car to the games. In many cases these people will be able to park further away and walk. However, there are a number of valid points in relation to this:

1. What happens for a fan who does not have a blue badge but can only walk 5 or 10 minutes and could not walk from the outside of the parking zone? Can some provision be made for them?
2. Is there a need for increased parking on the existing car parks, some of which are owned by Celtic FC, as I understand it? For example, should multi-storey car parks be considered by Celtic FC in order to provide more parking on the site and this would obviously help disabled and partially disabled supporters as well.
3. Celtic and others have raised the question of more public transport and I wonder what interaction there is between the Club, the City Council, First Bus (for the buses) and Abellio ScotRail (for the trains). It does seem to me that there should be consideration given to increased buses and trains on the days of matches to reflect demand.
4. I would reiterate my suggestion that we should strongly support a new railway station at Parkhead Forge probably where the railway line crosses Duke Street on the way to Airdrie. This would serve both football fans and a wider range of the public who use Parkhead Forge for shopping and students who attend the nearby Kelvin College. This would also give direct rail links to Edinburgh which is not possible at present using Dalmarnock Station.
5. The suggestion has been made that Celtic FC themselves put on special buses either specifically for disabled fans or fans in general, which could then link into the major transport hubs in the city centre. This is obviously related to the previous point about First Bus and the level of any extra buses required.
6. While supporting stricter parking controls within the zone, I wonder if other controls could be relaxed, e.g. in Bell Street and Hunter Street where double yellow lines are not required.

This clearly is a highly contentious issue and I have had many representations about it from both residents and football supporters. However, I remain of the view that the present situation cannot continue as it is completely unacceptable for local residents to have to go through what they do on a regular basis.
