## **UEFA European Championship (Scotland) Act 2020 Consultation Sessions**

From 12 June to 12 July 2020 Glasgow will be one of 12 cities to host matches as part of the UEFA EURO 2020 Tournament to commemorate the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Championship. Hampden Park will host three group games on 15<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup> and a round of 16 match on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2020. As a Host City, Glasgow will offer a programme of activity in the city throughout the Tournament.

In August 2019, we took the opportunity to inform you about some proposed changes relating to street trading, advertising and ticket touting, which we expected to be in place during the Championships. These changes have now been introduced in the form of the UEFA European Championship (Scotland) Act 2020.

The team are currently preparing guidance which is in draft format to accompany the legislation and are holding these consultation sessions to inform you of what these changes will mean. This document is in draft format given that the regulations accompanying UEFA European Championship (Scotland) Act 2020 have not yet been cleared by the Scottish Parliament.
