#### Closure of city centre buildings – access for staff and visitors

The following council buildings are now closed to the public: City Chambers West, 40 John Street, 229 George Street and 231 George Street.

You'll have to swipe your pass to get into the buildings as there will be no reception staff. If you don't have a pass then you should go to the gatehouse and you will be issued a day temporary pass.

All visitors to these buildings should also go to the gatehouse to be met by a member of staff. Make sure that you give your contact details to any visitors so that the Gatehouse staff can phone you.
