Staff at the Barlanark Family Learning Centre in the North East of the city are working hard to support local families.

Holly Potter, Team Leader said: "Weekly phone calls to our families highlighted that some of them were struggling for food and activities to keep the children entertained throughout this period of lockdown. So we decided to join forces with a local charity programme called Gladigator which provides hot meals for local children.

"We've turned the nursery into a twice weekly pick-up point for food which has been a vital support for local families. The programme has limited funding, so we've worked to raise £650 which will keep it going for another week or so."

Holly added: "We're supporting our families and children through Facebook and Twitter - posting activities such as asking our staff to upload virtual hug photographs and asking the children to do the same. We've also posted clips of colleague **Sylvia Rhymer**, **Lead Practitioner of Attainment** reading some of the children's favourite stories.

"We're doing everything we can to support the local community and to let our children, and their families and carers, know that we're thinking of them and wishing them well."
