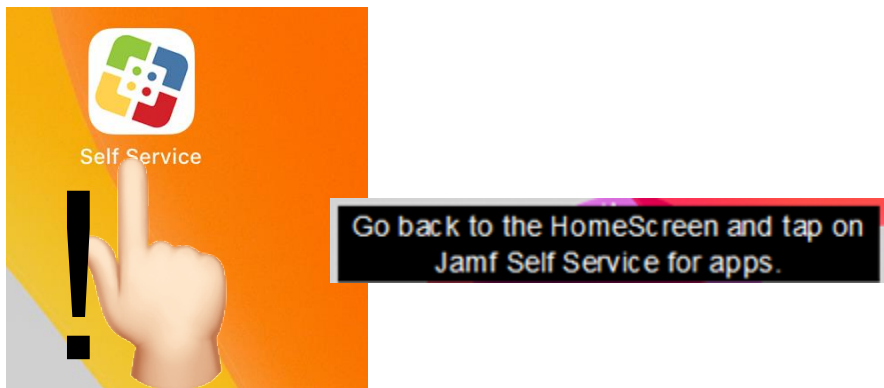

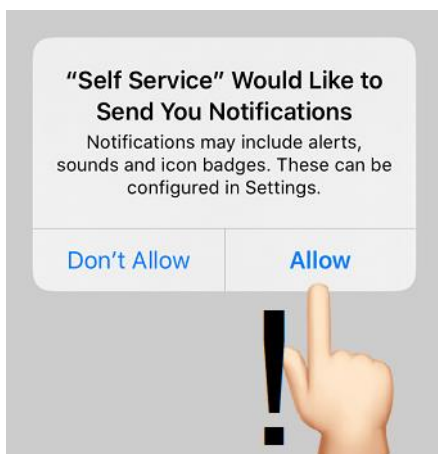

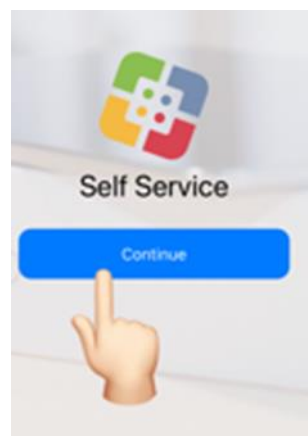
1. There is a selection of apps available through Self Service. These have all been approved and are free to download, but no more than 3 at a time.



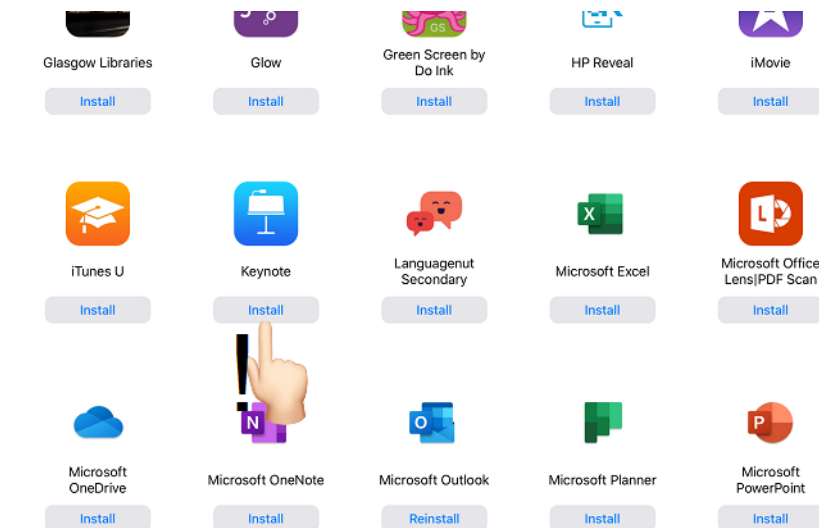
2. Tap on Allow for Notifications e.g. for updates to apps.



3. Tap on Continue.

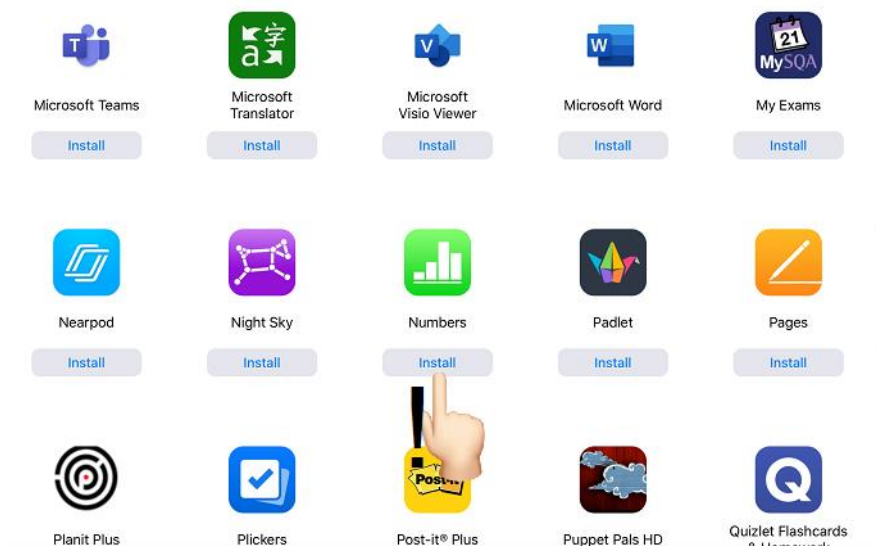


4. You will probably have to update the Apple iWorks apps as these have only recently been updated. Tap to install / reinstall Keynote



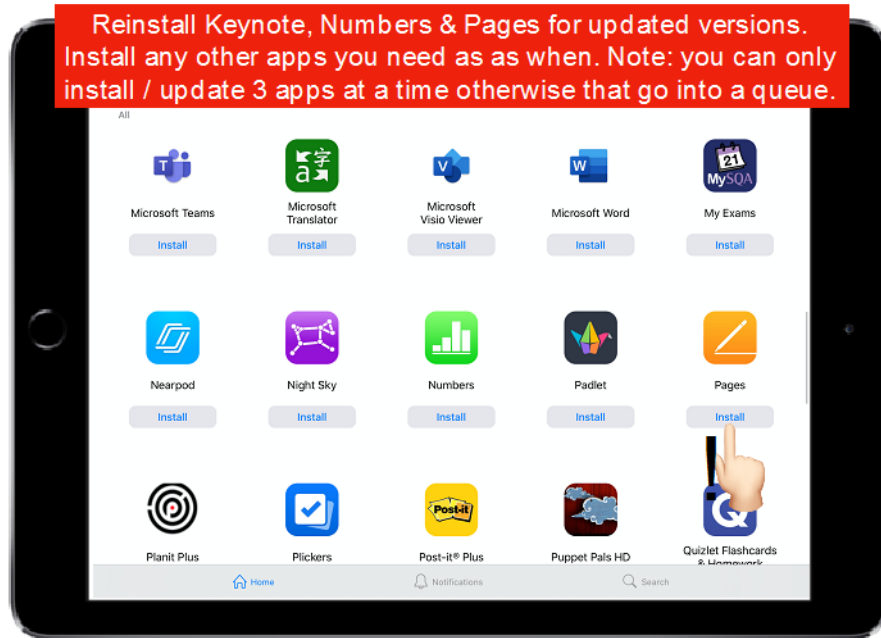
Reinstall Keynote, Numbers & Pages for updated versions. Install any other apps you need as as when. Note: you can only install / update 3 apps at a time otherwise that go into a queue.

5. You are best doing only up to 3 at a time, as they will queue up. Please also install / reinstall / update Numbers.

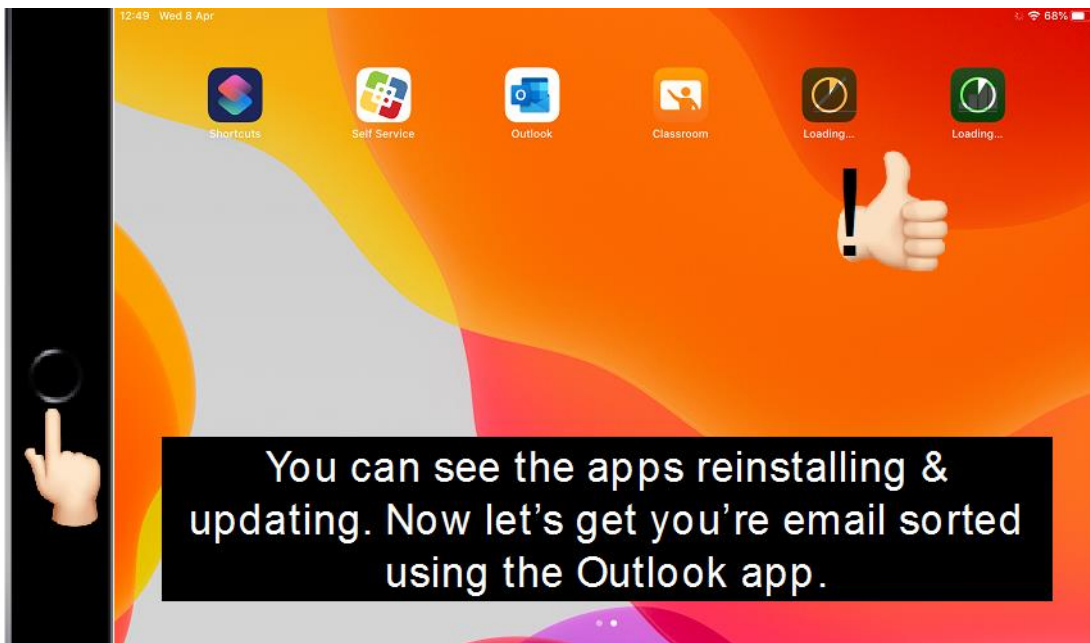

6. Please also install / reinstall / update Pages.



7. Tap on the Home Button to see the apps installing. Follow these steps to install any app needed e.g. Teams / OneDrive



If you want to access your GLOW email via the Outlook app, rather than signing into GLOW all the time, make sure Outlook is installed & follow "Accessing Glow Email with the Outlook App".
