What support do I receive?

Our staff will provide one to one support and when you're ready, work with you to create CV's, apply for jobs or attending training courses.

You will work on our programme at your own pace and be provided with the support needed to succeed!

Benefits to Joining ChoiceWorks

Being involved in ChoiceWorks is voluntary. However, if you are currently undertaking a Community Payback Order (CPO), engaging in our programme can possibly count towards your hours. We will also tailor the support that you require to take part in our programme. This could be, providing you with a travel pass or paying for training and development - Our team will work with you to ensure you get the support required.

Once you are ready, our Employment and Training Advisors can ensure you are supported in applying for jobs or college or explore training placements and volunteering opportunities.
