What's happening?

Glasgow City Council is thinking about how people and goods move around the city daily, how to transform the city centre, and how to create liveable neighbourhoods. We are writing 3 new transport-related plans on these issues.

The city is changing and growing. How, for what, and how much we travel is also changing.

We want you to be a part of a public conversation on Glasgow's transport future.

What should these new plans achieve?

We know that transport in our city needs to change and have been exploring the problems that need to be tackled.

We think that:

- Transport should contribute to a successful and just transition to a carbon neutral, clean and sustainable city
- Transport should play a positive role in tackling poverty, improving health and reducing inequalities
- Transport should respond and contribute to continued and inclusive economic success and a dynamic, world class city
- Places should be created where we can all thrive, regardless of mobility or income, through liveable neighbourhoods and an inclusive City Centre.
