

How to connect your laptop to Wi-Fi

If you don't know how to connect your Windows laptop to your Wi-Fi network, you've come to the right place.

Check the instructions below and you'll be able to connect your laptop to a wireless network very easily! Also, we've put together a few solutions you can try when your wireless network is not working properly.

The screenshots below are from a **Windows 10** laptop, but these steps also apply to **Windows 8 and 7** devices, the screens will vary.

1 Place your laptop somewhere close enough to your router (to ensure sufficient signal strength), power the device up and log-in.

When you reach your desktop screen, click the **network icon**

This will open up other hidden icons on W10

Click your Wi-Fi name and click on connect.



The first time you do this you will be asked for your password. You may have a card holding this code or check your router box.


Enter your password.

You have now connected to your Wi-Fi.

Click on the AOVPN tunnel box and select Connect, the status will change to connected.

Once you have secured Wi-Fi and AOVPN tunnel you have completed the Process and should be able to work as usual. The next time you log-on at home your laptop will automatically show your Wi-Fi name, click connect and follow the same process.
