1. This notification SHOULD come up automatically from the Home Screen. If so, tap Change Now, and go to step 1a. If not – go to step 2.



1a. Enter a Passcode: This is like a PIN to get into your iPad. Must be 6 digits BUT NOT ascending or descending. Now go to step 3.
