


How to set up your (Managed) Apple ID:

1. In Settings > Tap on "Finish Setting Up Your iPad" OR "Sign in to your iPad".




2. Tap on Set Up Apple ID.





3. Enter your Managed Apple ID, which has been created for you. This has been emailed to you from the Connected Learning Team.




4. DO NOT use your own personal Apple ID if you have your own Apple device. Tap Next






5. Enter your Temporary Password as supplied by the Connected Learning Project.




6. Tap Next






7. Have your mobile phone at hand and type in the number e.g. 07980025456. Make sure your select Text message.




8. Tap Send to receive a text message on your phone within a minute. Make sure you have phone signal.





9. Once you have received a text message, please enter the 6 digit code in the message e.g. 829765



10. You will now be able to create a password, unique to you. Please enter the temp password again (current), a new password & verify.



Current: Apple ID Password (emailed to you)

New: Must contain - 8 characters, a number, uppercase and a lowercase letter e.g. @3Oct2018

11. If it is not secure enough, you will need to re-enter all details again (step 10) so think carefully. If successful, you will be signed into iCloud for storage & data.

Now to get you access to the internet




You may at times, be required to update your Apple ID login details, so keep them safe. If you see a Notification (red dot), tap on Settings.




Tap Update Apple ID Settings and enter your Apple ID password (remember you changed the temporary one initially sent to you).



You can also go to General > Software Update and it will check for any iOS Updates.



If there is a Software Update, tap on Download & Install.






Enter your Passcode (6 digit PIN)




Also, please ensure you have 50% charge or are plugged into power & are connected to WiFi to complete update.







You may also be prompted to Backup your iPad.



Again make sure you are connected to WiFi & have 50% charge. Tap on Backup Settings.



Ensure the iCloud Backup toggle is green. Tap on Back Up Now.



Again make sure you are connected to WiFi & have 50% charge.
