Brockburn Road, Spaces for People Cycle Route, Glasgow (Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2021

Glasgow City Council has made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order.

 This Order may be cited as "Glasgow City Council (Brockburn Road, Spaces for People, Glasgow) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2021".

This Order makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven or park any motor vehicle, except authorised vehicles, on the following road.

PROHIBITION OF BEING IN A MANDATORY WITH FLOW CYCLE LANE

Brockburn Road

- On the Western Kerbline (northbound carriageway): from a point 40 metres south of the extended south kerbline of Brockburn Terrace, in a northern direction to a point 5 metres east of the extended eastern kerbline of Linthaugh Road.
- On the Eastern Kerbline (southbound carriageway): from a point 15 metres south of the extended south kerbline of Brockburn Terrace, in a northern direction to a point 10 metres east of the extended eastern kerbline of Linthaugh Road.

NO WAITING AND NO LOADING AT ANY TIME Brockburn Road

- On the Western Kerbline (northbound carriageway): from a point 40 metres south of the extended south kerbline of Brockburn Terrace, in a northern direction to a point 5 metres east of the extended eastern kerbline of Linthaugh Road.
- On the Eastern Kerbline (southbound carriageway): from a point 15 metres south of the extended south kerbline of Brockburn Terrace, in a northern direction to a point 10 metres east of the extended eastern kerbline of Linthaugh Road.

The Order will come into effect at 00:01 hours on Monday 1 March 2021 until 23:59 hours on Sunday 27 February 2022.
