(Traffic Management and Parking Controls) Order 2021

On Thursday 10 June 2021 Glasgow City Council made the above named Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order, which comes into operation on Monday 1 November 2021, was advertised in the Evening Times on Friday 28 February 2020 and the effect of the Order is as stated in said notice with the exception of the following.

- Replace one proposed disabled parking space on Wilton Street with one shared use parking space.
- Replace one proposed disabled parking space on Kelvin Drive with one shared use parking space.
- Relocate two parking bays on Hotspur Street for ease of buses turning to and from Queen Margaret Drive.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from 10 June 2021, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.
