Frequently Asked Questions – Road Closures

Will I be able to access my property during the road closures?

Access to properties and businesses within the road closure sites will be available subject to on-going operations and officers will be on site to help with entering or exiting the road closure site safely.

What will happen to my vehicle if it is left within the road closure site?

On-street notification will be displayed about 5 days in advance of the closure and vehicles will be issued with flyers about 2 days in advance of the closure.

Yellow 'no waiting' cones will be placed on the affected roads from 6pm the night before the closure. Once the cones have been placed a parked vehicles list will be taken and any vehicles parking in this area after the cones have been placed may be subject to a Penalty Charge Notice. Also, vehicles may be moved or removed by an uplift vehicle to assist with carrying out the works.

Please note: - If you are going to be away for an extended period of time when these road closures are planned then please provide the following details to

- Name and Address
- Vehicle Registration
- Location of parked vehicle
- Duration of time away

What happens if the works on my road are left incomplete?

An explanation as to why these works were left incomplete will be made available on the road closures timetable. The completion of these works will be added to the end of the existing programme.

Why were the works not carried out on my road on the date shown?

Road marking works are weather dependant which means that poor weather can cause delays. If this happens then the works will be added to the end of the existing programme. Details of this will be made available.

Can you take the opportunity to clean the roads while these closures are in place?

I can advise that it is hoped to carry out road cleansing operations when the road closures are in place.

I do not want these parking controls, can I object or have them stopped?

There is no longer a right of objection against these proposals.
