(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION)

ORDER 2022

Glasgow City Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “Glasgow City Council (Park Area, Glasgow) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2022” which will come into effect at 00:01 hours on Wednesday 2nd February 2022 until 23:59 hours on Friday 5 August 2022, or if this Order is revoked before this date.
2. This Order restricts the use of the following roads: -

Road	Restriction
Lynedoch Street - from Lynedoch Crescent to Lynedoch Place.	Road Closure – unlawful for any person, except authorised personnel, to access this section of road with any vehicle.
Lynedoch Place – from Park Circus Place to Woodlands Terrace	Road Closure – unlawful for any person, except authorised personnel, to access this section of road with any vehicle.
Woodland Terrace – from Lynedoch Place to no. 8 Woodlands Terrace.	Road Closure – unlawful for any person, except authorised personnel, to access this section of road with any vehicle.
Woodside Terrace – from Claremont Terrace to Elderslie Street.	Road Closure – unlawful for any person, except authorised personnel, to access this section of road with any vehicle.
Claremont Place – from Claremont Terrace Lane to Woodside Terrace.	Road Closure – unlawful for any person, except authorised personnel, to access this section of road with any vehicle.
Claremont Terrace Lane – from 27 Claremont Terrace Lane to Woodside Terrace Lane.	Road Closure – unlawful for any person, except authorised personnel, to access this section of road with any vehicle.
Woodside Terrace Lane – from Claremont Terrace Lane to 65 Woodside Terrace Lane.	Road Closure – unlawful for any person, except authorised personnel, to access this section of road with any vehicle.

Park Quadrant – from Park Terrace to Woodlands Gate.	Two Way Direction of Travel – temporary revocation of eastbound one way direction of travel to permit vehicles to use Park Quadrant in both directions.
Park Terrace – from Park Gate to Park Quadrant.	Two Way Direction of Travel – temporary revocation of northbound one way direction of travel to permit vehicles to use this section of Park Terrace in both directions.
Park Quadrant – from Park Terrace to Cliff Road.	North Side of Carriageway - No Waiting or Loading at any time.
Park Terrace – from Park Gate to Park Quadrant.	West Side of Carriageway - No Waiting or Loading at any time.

The reason for making the order is because due to a dangerous building, a safety exclusion zone has been introduced. The zone has temporarily closed some parts of the adjacent road network including sections of Lynedoch Street/ Lynedoch Place/ Woodlands Terrace/ Woodlands Terrace Lane/ Claremont Place. To maintain safety and access to the Park Circus area, the north side of Park Quadrant will be subject to temporary waiting and loading restrictions between Park Quadrant and Park Gate. This will allow two-way traffic on Park Quadrant to access the area from Woodlands Road via Woodlands Gate.

This Temporary Traffic Regulation Order is made by Glasgow City Council as Traffic Authority and is signed by an Officer with delegated authority in terms of the Council’s Scheme of Delegation, that officer being Andrew Mollon, Head of Roads, on 2nd February 2022.
