Request for an Extension of Time for making a Traffic Regulation Order in terms of Regulation 16 (4) of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1999

THE GLASGOW CITY COUNCIL (CELTIC PARK AND EMIRATES ARENA) (EVENT DAY EMERGENCY ROUTES AND PARKING ZONE) ORDER 20XX

I refer to your letter dated 21 September 2021 seeking a further extension, under regulation 16(4) of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1999, to the time limit on making the above order following publication of the proposal to do so in accordance with those regulations. As noted in your request, the Scottish Ministers have previously granted three 6 month extensions to the two year limit on making the order which expires on 3 November 2021.

The Scottish Ministers have considered the reasons set out in your request for a further 6 month extension, in particular relating to the impact of Covid 19 and the sisting of the hearing procedure by the appointed Reporters. Your request for a third 6 month extension has been granted and the matter of the relevant dates has been noted, as such the expiry date for the making of the above order is now 3 May 2022.

Please note that no other aspects of the order, beyond the reasons for requesting an extension, have been reviewed by Scottish Ministers.
