NOTICE OF ASSET TRANSFER REQUEST

An asset transfer request has been made to Glasgow City Council under Part 5 of the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015.

The request has been made by Hillwood Community Trust and relates to Priesthill Park, Priesthill Road, G56 6JB.

The request is for purchase of the land/building.

The proposed use of the land/building is for **Hillwood Community Trust to take** ownership of the site. They secured funding to develop a new football facility at the site. This was completed in September 2017. The Trust is now embarking on a funding programme to develop a new pavilion.
