Public Holidays 2022



As you may be aware, the Scottish Government announced an additional public holiday in 2022 to celebrate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee.

It has been agreed that the council will change the public holiday schedule for 2022 to match those announced by the Scottish Government.

For those working a standard five day working pattern, we have moved the late May Monday holiday from the 30 May to Thursday 4 June. Friday 3 June 2022 is an additional public holiday to mark the Queen's Platinum Jubilee and allow an extended break.

Part time staff and those on a non standard work pattern will be entitled to observe the additional public holiday on Friday 3 June if it is a scheduled work day. A day of toil will be added for other staff.
