
Approach & Methodology of Survey

The approach to the Greater Pollok LDF survey has been one which has sought to engage as many stakeholders and local people as possible. This has secured 1039 responses as well as written submissions. This has been achieved via a variety of methods Including targeted mail, extensive use of social media and working with established groups and key activists to make local people aware of the consultation.


Specific methods include the following:-

- 1) Promotion directly to all groups currently active in the area via Face-to-Face meetings, direct marketing via phone call and e mail.
- 2)Regular promotion of the survey via Twitter and Council press releases via the Evening Times
- 3) An audit of all Facebook and Twitter pages presently active in Greater Pollok followed by contact and sharing of a press release to all of their followers. Targeting of web administrators of Facebook pages including those in Nitshill, Darnley and Deaconsbank to encourage them to share the survey.
- 4) Targeting of all primary and secondary schools and inviting the participation of senior pupils as part of the Curriculum for Excellence and sharing the survey with parent's groups
- 5) Targeting of key employers including Silverburn, Sainsburys, Tesco, Leverndale and Rosshall Hospital to encourage them to share the survey with staff
- 6) Targeting of other groups including nurseries, bowling clubs, Foodbanks and Pantry and G53 businesses listed on yell.com to invite their participation
- 7) Targeting of key land and property owners
- 8) Inclusion of the survey within the Council newsletter to encourage staff who live in the area to participate and share news of the survey among friends and family
- 9)Targeting of homes for the elderly to encourage participation of staff and residents
- 10) Targeting of Community Council's and other local organisations who have applied for area partnership grant support during the last 3 years.
- 11) Encouraging partner organisations to share the survey among clients e.g. housing associations, library, health, and social care providers
- 12) Targeting of local elected members and invite them to share the survey on their local mailing lists
- 13) Promotion by Council officers of the survey via LinkedIn targeting those involved in the local development sector
- 14) Promotion of the survey via Reddit and its Glasgow discussion board
- 15) Promotion of the survey to all developers currently active in the area including Persimmon and Millar Homes
- 16) Promotion of the survey to neighbouring authorities of East Renfrewshire and Renfrewshire to identify any cross-boundary opportunities and to encourage them to promote the survey to staff who live within the area.
- 17) Inclusion of a summary of all previous survey findings undertaken in the last 15 years within the area on the consultation website.
- 18) Targeting of local volunteer and greenspace groups including Dams to Darnley and community festival organisations


Summary of Response rate since launch




Who responded? (Gender)




Who responded? (Employment Status)






Spatial Clusters of Comments








Traffic, cycle lane concerns, safety, and connectivity




