

If you are a taxi operator in Glasgow, Edinburgh, Dundee or Aberdeen you'll need to know about Low Emission Zones introduced in May 2022.

## Here's a snapshot of what LEZs are all about...

- LEZs aim to improve air quality by stopping the most polluting vehicles from entering the zone.
- Any vehicles entering a zone must meet minimum emission standards or will face a fine.
- LEZs will be enforced from 1 June 2023 in Glasgow, from 30 May 2024 in Dundee and 1 June 2024 in Aberdeen and Edinburgh.





Grants are available to cover up to 80% of the cost of a retrofit solution.

As an alternative to buying a new taxi or electric vehicle to meet LEZ standards, your existing taxi may be suitable for retrofitting.

- Up to 80% grant per light commercial vehicle or wheelchair accessible taxi to install exhaust after-treatment systems (capped at £6,000).
- Up to 80% grant per wheelchair accessible taxi is available to install LPG engine re-powering technology (capped at £12,000).
- Many petrol stations across Scotland have LPG fuel available for re-powered vehicles.
- LPG fuel is cheaper than petrol or diesel.
