
GCC Teaching Workforce


At 31st March 2023 the Council had 6452 teaching employees, an decrease of **0.3%** from March of the previous year. Of the teaching workforce in March 2022 79.2% were employed full time, which is consistent with the 79.9% of full time teaching employees recorded in March 2022.

Full Time/Part Time

Of the teaching workforce, 79.2% were full time workers. Of those full time workers 25% had self identified as Male, and 75% had self identified as Female. Between March 2022 and March 2023 there was a **1.2% decrease** in the number of full time workers, and a **3.3% increase** in the number




Full Time Workers Male (25%) Female (75%)


Part Time Workers Male (9.6%) Female (90.4%)

of part time workers. In male employees the number of full time workers fell by 1.2% between 2022 and 2023, and the number of part time workers fell by by 5.1%. In the number of female employees full time workers fell by 1.2%, and part time workers rose by 4.3%.









Female Employees with a Disability - 119






Sexual Orientation
