Response to consultation on proposed entry criteria and catchment area(s) for Notre Dame High School (Ward 23) - Proposals approved.

1 With reference to the minutes of 14th March 2019 (Print 7, page 538) approving a consultation exercise in relation to the entry criteria and catchment area for Notre Dame High School (Ward 23), Councillor Cunningham, City Convener for Education, Skills and Early Years, presented a report regarding the outcome of the consultation, advising

- (1) of the 3 options considered during the consultation period, namely, option 1, to leave the Notre Dame High entry criteria as it was, option 2, to retain the all-girl status but change the associated primary schools and thereby alter the local catchment area and option 3, change the school to be a co-educational denominational secondary school and alter the local catchment area, all as detailed in the report; and
- (2) of the full responses to the consultation.

After consideration, the committee agreed to approve option 3, that the entry criteria for Notre Dame High School be changed to co-educational and that the catchment

areas for Notre Dame High School be changed to include Notre Dame Primary School, St Patrick's Primary School and St Joseph's Primary School, with the catchment areas for St Thomas Aquinas Secondary School, St Roch's Secondary School and John Paul Secondary School also being changed, all as detailed in the report.
