

Parking zones review noted.

6 With reference to the minutes of 11th June 2019 (Print 2, page 110) noting the prioritisation of a current parking control work plan, there was submitted and noted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods and Sustainability regarding proposals to increase chargeable days and hours within existing parking control schemes at the request of local communities, advising

- (1) that when parking controls were initially proposed, the Council generally proposed the maximum chargeable days/hours that could be offered in terms of enforcement (Monday-Sunday, 8am-10pm) and on some occasions this had been implemented, however feedback received from local communities from consultation often resulted in a reduction of the proposed chargeable days/hours;
- (2) of the existing parking zones within the west end and surrounding city centre area along with the list of current chargeable days and hours for each zone, as detailed in the report;
- (3) that the Council had received requests from various local communities to consider extending the chargeable hours to deal with increasing problems at weekends and evening;
- (4) of the reasons for increasing the chargeable hours within existing zones;
- (5) of the proposal to include a project to increase chargeable hours in existing parking zones within the parking control work plan review and prioritise it accordingly; and
- (6) that an updated prioritised work plan would be submitted to this committee in November 2020.
