

Consideration of representations in relation to public procession by Partick Orange and Purple District 15 – Action agreed.

6 There was submitted a report by the Director of Governance and Solicitor to the Council advising of considerations in relation to a proposed procession to be held by Partick Orange and Purple District 15 on Sunday, 15th September 2019 and the need for this committee to consider representations, in terms of the Police, Public Order and Criminal Justice (Scotland) Act 2006 and the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982, as amended, in relation to the proposed procession.

After having heard

- (1) M Miller, Head of Licensing and Democratic Services, in further explanation of the report and who made representations regarding the risks to public safety, public order, damage to property and disruption to the life of the local community in relation to the proposed procession;
- (2) Superintendent J McBride, Police Scotland; and
- (3) Mr W Davidson, on behalf of Partick Orange and Purple District 15, in support of the proposed procession,

the committee agreed that the procession by the Partick Orange and Purple District 15 on Sunday, 15th September 2019 be prohibited in terms of section 63 (1) (i) of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982.
