

Fleet Strategy 2020-2030 noted – Recommendation to City Administration Committee

3 There was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods and Sustainability regarding the Council's new Fleet Strategy for 2020-2030, advising

- (1) that the Council operated a fleet, including plant equipment, of around 2,000 vehicles which was a vital component in delivering frontline services to the residents of Glasgow;
- (2) that the current fleet had an age profile which was not ideal for the demands of changing operational requirements and that now required to be replaced with modern vehicles and plant;
- (3) in addition to the need to replace the fleet was the need to make a fundamental change in vehicle emissions and to lead in the adoption of alternative fuels and the strategy committed the Council to the delivery of a net zero emissions fleet by the end of 2029;
- (4) that the strategy would begin the journey to make use of automation and telematics to monitor and achieve the efficiency gains vital to maintain front line services;
- (5) of the proposed fleet strategy, as detailed in the appendix to the report; and
- (6) of the key milestones and measures and that further updates would be provided to the committee as the strategy was developed.

After consideration, the committee

- (a) noted the report and supported the new Fleet Strategy 2020-2030; and
- (b) agreed to recommend to the City Administration Committee approval of the Strategy.
