

Glasgow City Council – Glasgow City Centre Enabling Infrastructure Public Realm project – Outline Business Case approved etc – Declaration of interest.

13 With reference to the minutes of 18th August 2015 approving the Strategic Business Case in respect of the Glasgow City Centre Enabling Infrastructure Public Realm project, there was submitted a report by the Director of the Programme Management Office (PMO) intimating that Glasgow City Council had submitted an Outline Business Case (OBC) in respect of the project, which, following evaluation by the PMO, had been considered and approved by the Chief Executives' Group on 30th November 2016 and was now being submitted to Cabinet for approval, advising

- (1) that the executive summary of the project, detailed in Appendix 1 of the report, described the strategic case, economic case, commercial case, financial case, sustainability case and management case;
- (2) that the project had been reviewed against the business case criteria outlined within the Glasgow City Region City Deal Business Case Guidance Template;
- (3) of the project risk register, as detailed in Appendix 2 of the report;
- (4) of the funding requirements as detailed; and
- (5) of the current benefits realisation requirements being met by this project.

After consideration and having heard a presentation on the project by Derek Dunsire, Glasgow City Council, the Cabinet

- (a) agreed that Glasgow City Council be invited to proceed to the next stage of project development through the preparation of a Full Business Case, subject to the OBC business case evaluation criteria being met in full;
- (b) noted the project risk register, as detailed in Appendix 2 of the report; and
- (c) approved the funding requirement of £15.61m.

Councillor McAveety declared an interest in this item and took no part in the discussion or decision thereon.
