

2017/18 Area Budget applications for funding dealt with etc.

6 With reference to the minutes of the Council's Executive Committee of 1st June 2017 approving an allocation of £56,845 to the Baillieston Area Budget 2017/18, there was submitted a report by the Director of Governance and Solicitor to the Council advising of the current position in relation to the Baillieston Area Budget 2017/18 and detailing a number of applications for funding.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (1) noted
 - (a) that to date, £21,765 had been allocated to various projects in the Baillieston Ward;
 - (b) an application deemed ineligible for Area Budget Funding and the reason it had been deemed ineligible;
 - (c) in relation to the £1,749 awarded to Coconut Corner Childcare Centre to purchase equipment and the organisation had not adhered to condition of grant in respect of how the funding was spent;
- (2) dealt with the applications for funding as follows, the grant awards being subject to the conditions detailed in the report:-
