(Agenda Item 2)	Proposed Variation of Lease for Scotstoun Stadium
Question (Baillie Scanlon)	Regarding 3.4 of the report, when will there be a charge for the service and what is the charge for electric vehicles?
Answer	<p>The City Administration Committee agreed on 8th April 2021 that a 16p/kWh tariff is imposed for all 7kW (slow) and 22kW (fast) chargers and 20p/kWh for 50kW (rapid) units.</p> <p>The units will be available to the public from the point they become operational on the following basis ;</p> <p>These units will be publicly available at all times apart from during rugby matches when they will be used by a community electric bus service who have been engaged to transport fans from the Partick Hub. So probably for 4 hours every second week they'll be restricted.</p> <p>Hence, we see this as a facility for visitors to the gym and local residents and therefore is strategically important for the West of the city.</p>
