(1) Councillor Cecilia O'Lone	In the recent Scottish Government's draft budget there is a proposed cut of £268 million to investment in social and affordable homes. How will this affect the residents of Glasgow, with waiting lists and homelessness already at crisis levels?
(2) Councillor Aileen McKenzie	To ask the City Convener for Education whether he recognises as legitimate the concerns raised by the EIS in relation to Health and Safety during the on-going pandemic, and whether the Council will consider the introduction of blended learning for the majority of students while Glasgow City Council remains in Level 4 restrictions?
(3) Councillor Eva Murray	To ask the City Convener for Sustainability and Carbon Reduction: the total number of pest control call outs since January 2020, how many of those relate to rats either within or outwith living areas, and the total cost to the Council of tackling rat infestations over the same period?
(4) Councillor Robert Mooney	To ask whether the Council will sign up to the UK Steel Charter, as supported by Community the Union, ten English and Welsh Local Authorities, and the Scottish Government?
(5) Councillor Kim Long	<p>“To ask the Leader to update on any planned civic programme for the COP26 conference later this year?</p> <p>In particular, plans to involve Glasgow's communities in COP26; and further how the Council might contribute a platform to delegates from the global south on the front line of climate change, to enable knowledge sharing from their expertise and resilience?”</p>
