

**Glasgow's Affordable Warmth programme - Delivery of 2022/23 programme etc noted – Instruction to Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability.**

**3** There was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability regarding a proposed programme in relation to the delivery of energy efficiency measures to owner-occupied and private landlord properties, utilising the Scottish Government's Home Energy Efficiency (HEEPS) programme: Area-Based Schemes funding for 2022/23, advising

- (1) that the HEEPS: Area-Based Schemes was an area-based approach to deliver insulation measures, mainly external wall insulation, to owner-occupied and private landlord properties and mixed tenure blocks, which was supported by funding from the Scottish Government and delivered by local authorities;
- (2) that the HEEPS: Area-Based Schemes 2021/22 programme had delivered energy efficiency measures to 206 private sector properties and 2,288 social rented housing completing a total of 2,494 properties;
- (3) that the Area-Based Schemes funding required all projects to be completed by 31st May 2023 with a final drawdown of funding no later than 30th June 2023 and that 9 project areas, as detailed in the report, would be funded from the 2022/23 programme; and
- (4) of the issues in delivering the Glasgow's Affordable Warmth Programme and the action being taken to encourage homeowners to take-up of these energy efficient measures.

After consideration, the committee

- (a) noted
  - (i) the completed Area Based Schemes project delivered during 2021/22; and
  - (ii) Glasgow's Affordable Warmth programme of works for the current year 2022/23; and
- (b) instructed the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability to report back to this committee on the progress of Glasgow's Affordable Warmth programme of works for the current year 2022/23.
