

**Severe Traffic and Road Conditions Issues (Ward 2) – Public Petition dealt with - Instruction to Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability.**

2 There was submitted a report by the Director of Legal and Administration advising of a petition on behalf of individuals, containing 97 signatures, 25 of which had been validated in accordance with the approved criteria, submitted by Caroline O'Toole, Principal Petitioner, as detailed in Appendix 1 of the report, which highlighted the petitioners' concerns and the outcomes sought by them in relation to their petition, together with comments from the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability regarding the issues raised in the petition, as detailed in Appendix 2 of the report.

The committee heard Caroline O'Toole, Principal Petitioner and Alison Bruce who highlighted a number of factual inaccuracies within the report, in support of the petition, which stated the petitioners' views and the aim of the petition to see how the Glasgow City Council Local Transport Strategy could assist to resolve the petitioners' problems, and encourage, in particular, traffic to use local vehicular distributor roads, along with traffic calming measures.

After consideration, the committee

- (1) agreed that the issues raised in the petition deserved further action; and
- (2) instructed the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability to undertake further direct engagement and consultation with the petitioners with a view to addressing the issues and concerns raised in the petition.
