

Area Budget 2022/23 - Applications for funding dealt with etc.

5 With reference to the minutes of the Council's City Administration Committee of 12th March 2020 (Print 7, page 527), when the committee approved the 2022/23 Area Budget allocations as part of a 3-year package of funding, there was submitted a report by the Director of Community Empowerment and Equalities regarding the Area Budget for 2022/23, advising

- (1) of the current position in relation to the Area Partnership's budget for 2022/23;
- (2) that the Pollokshields Area Partnership's Area Budget allocation for 2022/23 was £62,408.19; and
- (3) of the applications for funding from the Area Budget for 2022/23.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (a) noted
 - (i) the Area Budget allocation for 2022/23;
 - (ii) that, to date, Pollokshields Area Partnership had committed a total of £45,222 (73% of the budget) to various projects providing a service in the Ward, leaving a balance of £17,186.19 (27%) yet to be allocated; and
- (b) dealt with the applications for funding as follows, the grant awards being subject to the conditions detailed in the report:-
